Historic Plaque Application

Buildings will be judged individually. The primary criteria will be general conformity to an architectural period, and be 75 years old, but consideration will be given to the identification with significant personages, events and usages. The house, or building, should be representative of its period. The following guidelines are the ideal for authenticity, but need not be followed exactly so long as the general appearance conforms with the period of the structure. The external features should closely adhere to the following guidelines: Sheathing: clapboards, shingles; Windows: desirably consistent with the period (Colonial: 12/12, 12/8, 9/6, 6/6; Greek Revival: 6/6, 2/2; Victorian: 6/6, 2/2, 2/1, 1/1); Window frames: original, or accurate reproductions. Storm windows and doors that do not detract from the proportions of the building; Paint color: of the period; chimney: sympathetic to the period in general appearance.

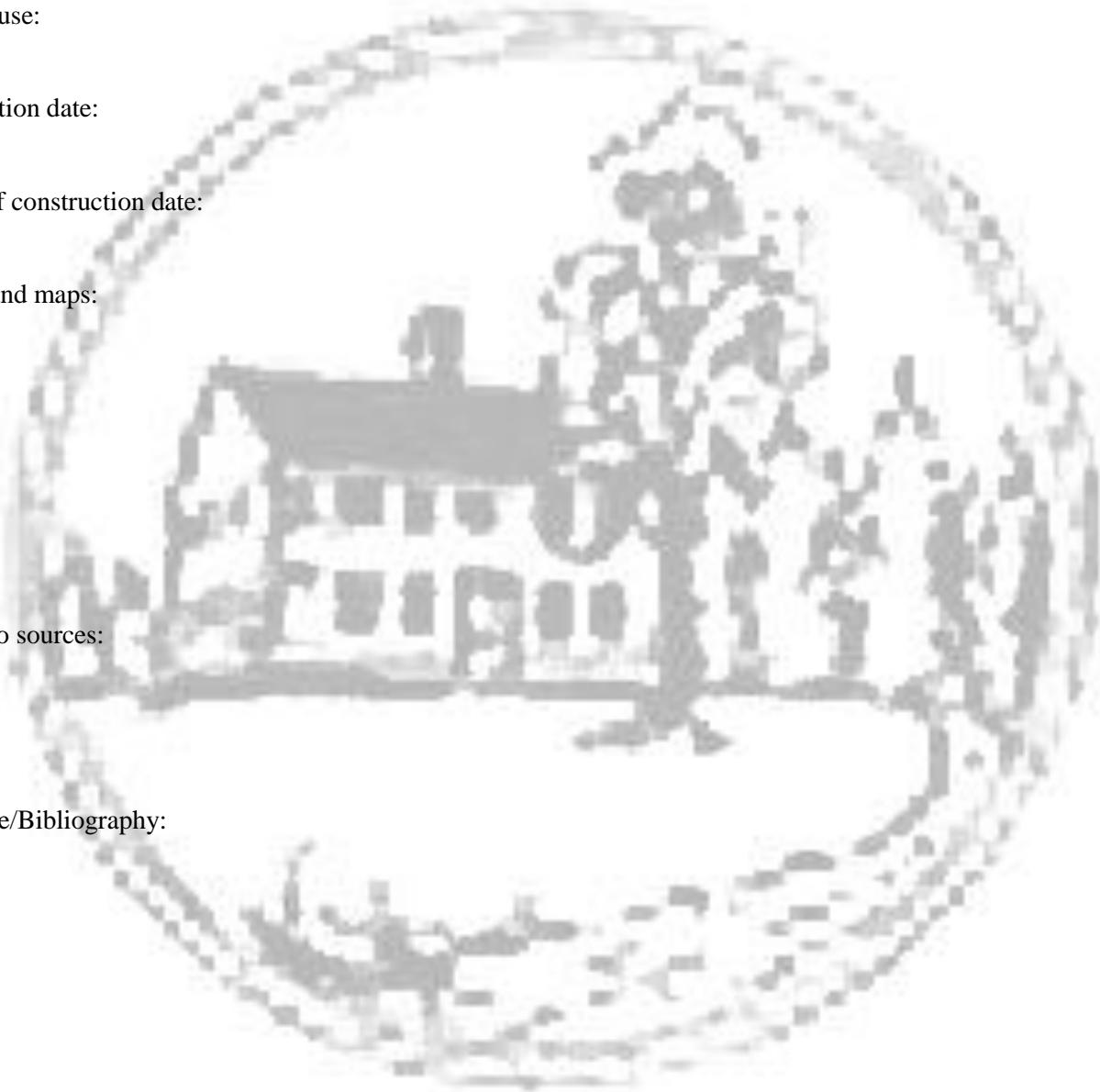
